MARATHON-VILLAGE INTERLAKEN

The Marathon-Village is located between the Congress Kursaal Interlaken and the Höhematte in Interlaken. The square is not covered.

MARATHON-VILLAGE GRINDELWALD

The Marathon-Village is located at the baggage collection and the showers in the intermediate wing of the Eiger-Express bottom station in Grindelwald Terminal and is not covered.

Opening hours: Saturday, from 12.00 to 07.00 pm

Food stands have different conditions. Please contact us directly.

All prices are exclusive of VAT and include electric power (230 V/max. 2000 watt), which must be requested specifically.

FURTHER PORVISIONS

Any lighting required must be brought by the exhibitor. Additional services are available at extra cost. Please request an additional quote for your specific requirements.

- Please bring your own extension cables, lamps and connectors.
- Please bring your own tent and stand equipment. Each stand operator is responsible for anchoring/fixing their own tent to the ground.
- Any transport of stand material from Interlaken to Grindelwald Terminal must be organised by your own.
- The stand/tent placement will be determined by the organizers.
- Each exhibitor must dispose of their own waste! Waste disposal in Interlaken is subject to charge. Any waste left behind will be charged to the exhibitor. **CHF 100.00 / per waste container!**
- The Marathon-Village regulations are a binding part of the agreement and will be sent with the invoice.
- The deadline for stand reservations is **30 June 2026**.
- The deadline for payment is **10 August 2026**.

INSTALLATION

Interlaken: Friday, 4 September 2026, from 07.00 to 09.00 am

Grindelwald Terminal: Saturday, 5 September 2026, from 09.00 to 11.00 am

The exact installation schedule (time window for each exhibitor) will be sent in writing to the exhibitors by mid-August. The installation schedule must be strictly adhered to. **Installation during the village opening times is strictly forbidden.**

Vehicles may only enter the event grounds for unloading purposes within the allocated time window and with exhibitor authorization. Access to the event grounds will be monitored.

PARKING PASS FOR EXHIBITORS

Interlaken: Parking on the event grounds is prohibited.

Grindelwald Grund: Parking is available in the parking garage (Terminal) or in the open car park (larger vehicles).

DISMANTLING

Interlaken: Friday from 08.00 to 9.30 pm

Grindelwald Terminal: Saturday from 07.00 to 08.30 pm

The exact schedule for dismantling on Friday will be sent in writing to the exhibitors by mid-August 2026. The dismantling schedule must be strictly adhered to. **Dismantling during the village opening times is strictly forbidden.**
